Any individual or collective act or practice or ragging shall constitute an act or gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under the provisions of this ordinance.

Ragging, for the purposes of this ordinance, shall ordinarily mean any act, conduct or practice by which the dominant power or statues of senior students is brought to bear upon the students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by the former and includes individual or collective acts or practices which

a. Involve physical assault or threat to use physical force.

b. Violate the status, dignity and honour of students, in particular women students and those belonging to a scheduled caste or scheduled tribe;

c. Expose students to ridicule or contempt or commit an act which may lower their self esteem; d. Entail verbal abuse, mental or physical torture, aggression, corporal punishment, harassment,

trauma, indecent gesture and obscene behaviour.

INTERNAL COMMITTEE (IC) POLICY

In compliance with the instructions of the National Commission for Women and guidelines issued in implementation of the directives of AICTE on the subject of sexual harassment of women in the workplace, the Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Technology (MAIT) has duly constituted an Internal Complaint Committee for considering complaints of Sexual Harassment of Women Working and girl students in all the Departments of MAIT.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the IC to Prevent Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace are as follows:

- To develop a policy against sexual harassment of women at MAIT.
- To ensure the implementation of the policy in letter and spirit through proper reporting of the complaints and their follow-up procedures.
- To uphold the commitment of the institute to provide an environment free of gender-based discrimination.
- To promote a social and psychological environment to raise awareness of sexual harassment in its various forms.
- To create a secure physical and social environment to deter any act of sexual harassment.
- To evolve a mechanism for the prevention and redressal of sexual harassment cases.

FUNCTIONS

- Redressal of complaints with fairness and without bias.
- To organize workshops for employees to educate all employees of the institute about Sexual harassment at the workplace, its effects, and laws against it;
- To apprise about the filing of a complaint with the IC
- Recommend interim measures as needed (mainly for the complainant) to conduct a fair inquiry.
- The mechanism for registering complaints should be safe and accessible.

PROCEDURE

Complaints regarding Sexual Harassment against women can be made in paper form or by sending an e-mail to the convenor or any member. An aggrieved woman can make a written complaint of sexual harassment at the workplace to the IC (in case a complaint is against the employer), within three months from the date of the incident and in case of a series of incidents, within three months from the date of last incident. As per the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Rules, 2013. The Role of the IC is to examine the situation to assess shortcomings both at the level of gender sensitization and sexual harassment-related redressal systems and to suggest measures, and recommendations for improvement to the justice system and protection of rights for both the victim and the accused. The constitution of IC is to explore the current situation prevailing on campus with the safety of women and girls.

 A complainant may appear in person to present his case. The principles of natural justice shall guide the IC. The Internal Committee shall ensure the disposal of every application as speedily as possible. This will be forwarded to the senior faculty mainly women in charge.. She will submit the report within 7 days after a threadbare inquiry.

This will be again forwarded to the action in-charge committee and reports will be submitted to the final authority, the director.

On the conclusion of proceedings, the IC shall pass such order with reasons, as may be deemed fit to redress the grievance and provide such reliefs that may be desirable to the affected party at issue.

EXCLUSIONS:

- The committee is NOT to act as moral police; neither will it intrude on anyone's privacy.
- The role of the Committee is to create awareness about sexual harassment and to deal with and recommend punishment for non-consensual acts of sexual harassment within the campus.
- The IC will not insist on a graphic description of the sexual harassment.
- The IC shall ensure confidentiality while dealing with the matter.
