She also elaborated that due to current lockdown, How small vendors and Street Food hawkers are suffered? .Almost all the migrant workers were asked to leave the place. For them, basic step has been taken by the Indian Government for the sake of migrant workers by providing them the small capital of Rs 10000. A coal mining industry which is very much dependent on Australia for import should be taken into consideration. The infrastructure should be developed within our country for coal mining production and mining
